Some of the key features of the Tariff Order are as follows:

1. Delayed Payment Surcharge (DPS) linked with Bank rate plus 500 basis points on monthly basis with increase of 50 basis points monthly subject to a maximum of yearly 700 basis points as specified in Clause 10.75 of the JSERC (Terms & Conditions for determination of Distribution Tariff) Regulations, 2020.
2. Fixed Charge recovery linked to nos. of hours of supply. For HT consumers- 23 Hours and LT Consumers -21 Hours for recovery of full fixed charge.
3. Prompt payment rebate of 2% on bill value (Capacity Charges and Energy Charges) for payment within 5 days of the presentation of bills as specified in Clause 10.76 of the JSERC (Terms & Conditions for determination of Distribution Tariff) Regulations, 2020.

4. Due date for payment will be 15 days for LT domestic, Commercial and Agricultural consumers and 21 days for all other Consumers as per Clause 10.1.5 of the JSERC (Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2015.
5. Additional 1% rebate shall be applicable for payment of entire billed amount within due date made either through online or any digital mode subject to a maximum ceiling of Rs. 250 against the billed amount.
6. Rebate of 3% on Energy charges for switching to pre-paid metering.
7. Rebate at the rate of 1% on bill amount per month for delayed billing beyond two months or part thereof, shall be applicable subject to a ceiling of 3%.
8. Voltage Rebate: Applicable on Demand and Energy charges as per the JSERC (Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2015 for HTS/HTIS (33 kV): 3%, HTS/HTIS (132 kV): 5%, HTS/ HTIS (220 kV): 5.5%, HTS/ HTIS (400 kV): 6%
9. Load Factor Rebate: For every X% increase in Load Factor above 65%, X % rebate will be allowed to HTS & HTIS consumers on total energy charges corresponding to total energy consumption subject to a maximum ceiling rebate of 15%.
10. The above rebate will be available only on monthly basis and consumer with arrears shall not be eligible for the above rebate. However, the applicable rebate shall be allowed to consumers with outstanding dues, wherein such dues have been stayed by the appropriate Courts.
11. ToD Tariff is applicable as an option to HTS and HTIS consumers
12. Attractive Gross/Net metering tariff retained for promotion of Renewable energy.
13. Single Part Tariff equal to the Average Cost of Supply (ACoS) is applicable for public EV charging stations operating in the supply area of DVC in the state of Jharkhand.

The details of the rates and rebates mentioned above along with other terms & conditions are available in the Tariff order for FY 2024-25 issued by the Commission on September 30, 2024.
